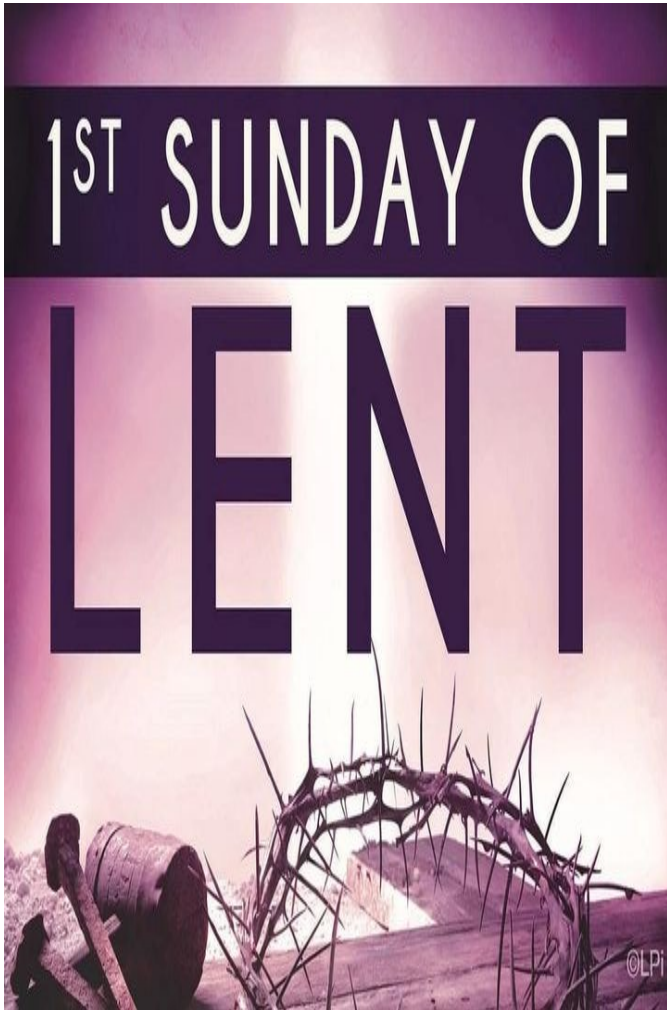


SILENT MEDITATION
