### FREE YOGA CLASSES IN THE NEW CHAPEL

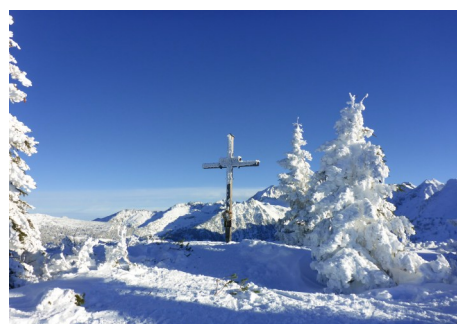
